Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application and subsequent correspondence with the school/ inspection in this regard, I convey the grant for provisional recognition to **Apollo Star International Public School, Rahon, Distt. S.B.S. Nagar (Punjab)**, for class 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Std. upto 31.03.2026.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. This grant does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize/ affiliate beyond class VIII.
2. The school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2010.
3. The school shall admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide Free and Compulsory Elementary Education till its completion. Provided, further that in case of pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
4. For the children referred in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per Section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursements, school shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The School/ Society shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
6. The school shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof, if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended provided prescribed for admission on ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them. The school shall ensure:
  - a) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
  - b) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
  - c) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
  - d) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 25 of the Act.
  - e) To include child of special needs as per provisions of the Act.
  - f) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid down under Section 23(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act, do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years. Attach list of the Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff.
  - g) The teacher performs its duties specified under Section 24(1) of the Act and;
  - h) The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by the appropriate authority.
7. The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by the appropriate authority.
8. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of school.
9. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development.
10. The school is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
11. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
12. The accounts shall be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy of each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the DEO every year.
13. The Recognition Code Number allotted to your school is **RTE-467**. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office.
14. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Director of Education/ District Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Govt./ Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the conditions of the Recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
15. Renewal of registration of society, if any, be ensured.
16. The school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in Section 19 of the School Act.
17. The school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (Amendment) Act, 2017 dated 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 as per letter issued by the Government of India.
18. School will be liable to renew Fire Safety Certificate & Water and Sanitation Certificate from time to time.
19. If any document submitted by school online found false, the recognition granted to the school can be cancelled.
